In June 2020, following the death of George Floyd, the UN Human Rights Council held an urgent debate on “current racially inspired human rights violations, systemic racism, police brutality and violence against peaceful protests”. The Human Rights Council adopted by consensus resolution 43/1.

The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights is **now seeking inputs** to inform the preparation of the report by the High Commissioner for Human Rights pursuant to HRC resolution 43/1 on “systemic racism and violations of international human rights law against Africans and people of African descent by law enforcement agencies.
